

The ATLAS group at the University of Freiburg (Prof. Karl Jakobs/ Dr. Christian Weiser) has an opening for a

Postdoctoral Position.

Our group has long-standing experience in Higgs boson physics, studies of Supersymmetry, Standard Model measurements and is also engaged in the operation of the ATLAS Semiconductor Tracker (SCT) and in upgrade projects on silicon strip detectors (ATLAS ITk).

The focus of the postdoc activities will be on the search for Supersymmetry with LHC Run-2 data, in particular targeting a potential partner of the top quark. The candidate is expected to play a leading role in the field. This involves supervision of graduate students. Participation in an ATLAS combined performance group (e.g. the flavor tagging group) or detector operation (SCT) is expected. Being based at CERN for an extended duration is possible.

The position is limited to a duration of three years with the possibility of an extension by one more year. Payment is according to the German TV-L system. The University of Freiburg is an equal opportunity employer. Suitable qualified women as well as persons with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Applicants should hold a doctoral degree in physics and should have demonstrated excellent skills in particle physics data analysis. They are expected to participate to some extent in teaching at the faculty.
