The position is part of a cohort hire across a number of faculties and fields of study. The successful candidate will be joining a vibrant scholarly community at York, where we aspire to achieve equity and diversity in all areas, including race equity. The successful candidate must have earned a doctoral degree (or is close to completion and in hand by the start date) in physics, biophysics, astrophysics, astronomy, or a closely related field. Postdoctoral experience is desirable. The successful candidate will be expected to develop an externally funded research program, supervise graduate students (prompt appointment to the Faculty of Graduate Studies), foster research linkages within and beyond York, and play an active role in widely promoting York's endeavours in research and education.

- Note that applicants who are invited to interview will be asked to have three letters of reference submitted on their behalf.
